TREATMENT OF STUDENTS POLICY

1.00 PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines for the treatment of students at Coast Mountain College.

2.00 DEFINITIONS

3.00 POLICY STATEMENT

- 3.1 With respect to the treatment of students or potential students, the President & CEO shall not cause nor allow conditions, procedures, or decisions which are unsafe, inhumane, unfair, disrespectful, in violation of human rights, or that fail to provide appropriate confidentiality and privacy, or appropriate access to education.
- 3.2 Further, without limiting the scope of the above statement, the President & CEO shall not:
 - a. discriminate against anyone for respectfully expressing an ethical dissent
 - b. prevent students from grieving to the Board of Governors when internal grievance procedures have been exhausted, and the student alleges that Board policy either:
 - i. has been violated to his or her detriment, or
 - ii. does not adequately protect his or her human rights
 - c. fail to acquaint students with their rights and responsibilities
 - d. operate without clear written guidelines for the handling of student complaints.
